| 1. “No one can come to Me unless the Father who sent Me draws him.”

John 6:44,65 | <i>We must respond to God, who gave His only Son.</i> | 6. “Unless one is (born again) born of water and the Spirit, he cannot see the kingdom of God.”

John 3:3,5 | <i>We must receive Jesus’ baptism of water and Spirit.</i> |
| 2. “Unless you see signs and wonders, you will by no means believe.”

John 4:48 (NKJV adds <i>people</i>) | <i>We must recognize Jesus’ resurrection.</i> | 7. “Unless I wash you, you have no part with Me.”

John 13:8 NIV | <i>We must allow Christ, the body of Christ, to wash our feet.</i> |
| 3. “Unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.”

Matthew 18:3 | <i>We must renew our minds and humble our hearts.</i> | 8. “Unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day.”

John 6:53-54 | <i>We must remember Jesus’ sacrifice for our sins.</i> |
| 4. “Unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone...He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.”

John 12:24-25 | <i>We must realize this world is passing away.</i> | 9. “As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you abide in Me...If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.”

John 15:4,6 | <i>We must abide in the Spirit and body of Christ (His Church).</i> |
| 5. “The Son can do nothing of Himself, unless it is something He sees the Father doing; for whatever the Father does, these things the Son also does in like manner ... as the Father raises the dead and gives them life, even so the Son also gives life to whom He wishes.”

John 5:19-20 NASB | <i>As sons of God, we must imitate Christ. We begin with His baptism.</i> | 10. “Unless your righteousness exceeds the righteousness of the scribes and Pharisees, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven.”

Matthew 5:20 | <i>We must do the will of God. We cannot enter the kingdom of heaven by the teachings and traditions of men.</i> |

Jesus gave us one more condition of salvation, using the expression “if for no.”

¹ Jesus used the expression “if not,” “ean me” in the original greek text to give us these ten conditions. Jesus used the expression “if not” in only two other occasions in the gospels, in passages unrelated to salvation; “if for no,” “ean gar me,” translated “unless” is used in John 8:24.
